

# Skin Type Assessment

The decision on what level solution to use on your clients will depend on their skin type. Refer to the chart below when choosing the appropriate solution level. Make sure to ask first time clients about their tanning goals and any problem areas they hope to address.

Keep in mind the goal is to look natural. Advise your clients that darker is not always natural on certain skin tones. If your clients demand a darker result suggest a second session within 24 hours. Make sure to use a lighter shade than you would normally use.

Level	Skin Type	What To Look For	Recommended Solution
Level 1	Very fair skin	Extremely sensitive to the sun and can sunburn easily. Has red undertones and cannot achieve a tan.	Sol Potion No. 6
Level 2	Fair skin	Sensitive to the sun. Has fair skin with redder undertones. Has difficulty achieving a tan.	Sol Potion No. 9
Level 3	Fair to medium skin	Medium skin tones that have no red undertones. Can achieve a medium tan.	Sol Potion No. 10
Level 4	Medium to dark skin	Medium to olive skin tones. Can achieve a medium to dark tan.	Sol Potion No. 11.5
Level 5	Dark skin	Deep olive or dark brown skin tones. No sensitivity to the sun and never sunburns.	Sol Potion Wicked

**NOTE:** Wicked has the deepest coloring which can produce a redder effect. This solution should only be used on clients that already have very dark skin. Like all our solutions, Wicked can be mixed with other Sol Potion solutions to create depth to lower level colors.
